## History of Community & School by Steve Flores

The town of Field was established with a post office in 1907. Most of the residents were homesteaders from Texas. The name Field (sometimes called "Fields") has an unknown origin. Since there are many Fields in the area, maybe that's how it got its name. The school in Field was created when three rural schools consolidated. There are no stores in the area. Field was never a village, but a school that people in the area attended. After the high school was closed in 1957, the building was used as an elementary school for several years. Students from the area now attend school in Melrose.
