### History of the Community and School by Steve Flores

Lourdes was a Catholic School that served grades 9-12. It was first opened in the 1930's and closed in 1966. Enrollment began to decrease after the opening of St. Pius in 1958. By the mid 1960's, the school could no longer afford to stay open. It was one of several Catholic high schools to close in the 1960's.

The school and gymnasium are still standing. Joy Junction currently owns them and the headquarters for Joy Junction is in front of the old school. The school and gymnasium are fenced off for safety reasons. The gym is in poor shape and will probably not remain standing much longer.
