### History of the Community and School by Steve Flores

McAlister was settled by homesteaders. In 1907, A. I. McAlister and his wife opened a grocery store and a post office. The area grew quickly into a thriving farming and ranching community. The farmland in the area was very rich for growing just about anything. They never had a population greater than 300 and never had more than a few stores. The depression years and the drought caused many people to leave the area. By 1940, over half the people had moved away. Today the post office remains open, but there are no stores in the town. A couple of dozen houses remain in the community. McAlister School is still standing. It was converted into a private residence in 2004. The gymnasium was torn town in the 1980's.
