History of Town and School by Steve Flores

Our Lady of Sorrows school was a Catholic School serving Bernalillo since the early 1930's. The school was located next to the OLOS Church on Main Street. The school (often called Bernalillo High School) served grades 1-12. In the 1950, after Bernalillo High School (Public) was built, the school began to see a decrease in enrollment. The school was one of seven Catholic schools that closed in the 1960's. The school with gymnasium is still standing. The gym is used by the town of Bernalillo for recreational purposes.
