History of Town and School by Steve Flores

Prairieview was established by homesteaders in the early 1900's. The town had a post office, a store, and the school but never had more than a couple hundred residents. The economy was based on farming and ranching. Today only a couple of houses along with the abandoned school remain. There are no signs letting visitors know where the town was located. The school building is the only indication to visitors that they are in Prairieview. The school was consolidated with Lovington in 1942, and the old gym was used as a community center for several years.
