History of the Town and School by Steve Flores

The town of Rogers was established in 1906, by homesteaders from many areas. One homesteader, Rev. Andrew J. Maxwell, moved to the area from Rogers, Arkansas. He was responsible for laying out the town and establishing a post office. The town's economy was largely based on farming and ranching. Today the area has a couple dozen houses and a post office. The Rogers Gym is still used today. It was moved to Dora and is used as their main gym. The old school and original gym are currently being used as a garage to store farm equipment.
