History of the Town and School by Steve Flores

People from Texas and the midwest settled the town in 1905. The town had its first post office in 1912. The town was called Bellview and in 1918 was changed to Rosedale. There were never more than a couple of hundred people in Rosedale and only a couple of stores. It was mostly a farming and ranching community. Today there are few buildings in the town and the population is less than 20. The school building is currently used as a barn to house livestock. The gym caught fire in the early 1980's and was completely destroyed.
