History of the Town and School by Steve Flores

Taos Central Catholic opened in the mid 1950's, serving grades 1-12. It was one of several Catholic schools that opened as a result of the Dixon case which prohibited Catholic Nuns from teaching in public schools. Financial difficulties led to the closing of the school. Ironically, the school received the letter that it would have to close only a few days after the boy's basketball team won the state championship.

The school is currently being used by the church for catechism classes for Catholic students in Taos. The gymnasium is used by the City of Taos for recreational purposes.
