History of Town and School by Steve Flores

The area of Trementina was originally established by the Apache. Later the Spanish settled the area. The Spanish settlers supplemented their substance agriculture by selling pine oil and turpentine. By 1910, the town had over 300 residents. Trementina had a school, church, hospital, and several stores. The population drifted away with World War I, the Depression, and the drought of the 1930's. In the 1940's a new Trementina emerged five miles from the previous site. A new school was built in the area. Today, the school building, a fire department, and a few houses are all that remain.
